ECONOMIC HEADLINES

- Inflation picked up in June, with the CPI 2.7% higher than a year ago.
- The producer price index was flat in June.
- Retail sales rose more than expected last month.
- The S&P 500 and Nasdaq posted gains last week, while the Dow fell slightly.
- Initial claims for unemployment fell to their lowest level in three months.
- President Trump threatened to impose "secondary tariffs" on Russia's trade partners "at about 100%" if President Putin does not agree to a deal to end his invasion of Ukraine in 50 days.
- The largest Wall Street banks posted better-than-expected results in the second quarter.
- Economists this month <u>dialed back their earlier pessimism</u> that U.S. trade policies would lead to slower growth and higher inflation this year.
- President Trump denied that he plans to fire Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell.
- The Port of Los Angeles says that <u>shipping container traffic has increased</u> as importers race to beat the latest deadlines set by President Trump for tariffs.
- Here are 10 of the most expensive cities for high-net-worth individuals, according to Swiss bank Julius Baer.
- International inbound travel to the U.S. shows mixed recovery.
- Insurers just marked the costliest first half of the year since 2011.

HOUSING NEWS

- Mortgage demand fell 10% in the week ending July 11.
- Mortgage rates rose for the second straight week.
- According to NAR, <u>international buyer demand rose</u> for the first time in eight years.
- Nearly one-third of major U.S. housing markets now see falling home prices.
- Housing starts rose in June.
- These were the hottest housing markets in June, according to realtor.com.
- Homebuilders are slashing prices at the highest rate in three years.
- About 5.5 million more households would be able to afford a home if rates drop to 6%, according to NAR.
- The 'lock-in effect' is making it harder to buy a home—even if mortgage rates fall.
- More than 60 real estate agents nationwide have lost a combined \$15 million in cryptocurrency scams.
